Terms for Election of Officers

PURPOSE:

The purpose is to promote continuity by ensuring members elected to be chair or vice-chair may serve for two consecutive terms.

POLICY:

In accordance with the Health Protection and Promotion Act Section 52, at the first meeting of the Board of Health in each year, the members shall elect one member to be chair and one to be vice-chair.

In accordance with By-Law No. 1, any member of the Board of Health may serve as an Officer of the Board in the position of chair or vice-chair, provided they are elected. The term for each Officer position shall be one year.

Incumbents may be re-elected for a total of two consecutive terms before a one-year break in the role served before being re-elected for another term, in accordance with Bylaw No. 1.
