



COVID-19 Quarantine Plan for Temporary Foreign Workers

Anyone arriving to Canada must quarantine for 14 days. This includes Temporary Foreign Workers. During quarantine, workers are to remain two meters apart at all times, must remain isolated from other people on the farm, may not leave the property (except to seek medical attention) and must not work.

A quarantine plan is required to be submitted to Southwestern Public Health (SWPH) at least two weeks prior to worker arrival for a Public Health Inspector's review and approval.

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Any worker who develops symptoms, or fails a health check, must immediately isolate and SWPH must be contacted for further direction.
