

Licensed Child Care Entry Immunization Questionnaire (New Clients and Address Changes)

Health Units review the immunization records of children to make sure they have had all their needles. This keeps children and the child care community safe. We need a copy of your child's immunization record to find out if they need any other needles. Having your child immunized, or a legal exemption, is required by law (Child Care and Early Years Act).
