## **Ages 12-17 Eligible for COVID-19 Vaccine Booster**

Effective February 18, Individuals aged 12-17 will be eligible to book a third dose COVID-19 vaccine booster appointment at Southwestern Public Health mass vaccination clinics.

- Must be 12 years of age or older on the date of vaccination
- Those aged 12-17 will be given Pfizer-BioNTech as advised by the Ministry of Health
- Advised to be at least 6 months (168 days) since a second dose
