## Frozen Mango Recall

The CFIA has issued a **food recall warning** for various frozen mangoes sold under various brands. Canadians have been advised by the CFIA not to eat any recalled food products and to see a health care provider if they have consumed the exposed recalled products or have symptoms consistent for Hepatitis A.

As of July 31, 2021, there are three laboratory-confirmed cases of Hepatitis A illness being investigated in the following provinces: Québec (2), and Nova Scotia (1). Individuals became sick between late March 2021 and mid June 2021. No hospitalizations or deaths have been reported. Individuals who became ill are between 23 and 63 years of age. The majority of cases (67%) are female.

Vaccination can prevent the onset of symptoms if given within 14 days of exposure.
