COVID-19 Vaccine Eligibility Update for the Southwestern Public Health Region

Starting today, adults aged 45 and older who live in an N5H postal code are now eligible to book an appointment.

Proof of age and proof of residence is required to gain access to an appointment at Southwestern Public Health's immunization clinics.

How to book:

- Pharmacy: Book directly with participating pharmacies, not through public health. Visit [covid-19.ontario.ca/vaccine-locations](https://www.covid-19.ontario.ca/vaccine-locations) for details.
- Primary Care: Participating primary care providers will inform their patients directly if they administer vaccines. Please do not call your primary care provider to ask if they have vaccines.
- Public Health Clinics: Call 226-289-3560 from 8 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. (Toll Free at 1-888-333-2175), or book online at www.covidvaccinelm.ca.

A reminder that all adults aged 40 and older in Ontario are also eligible at participating primary care providers and participating pharmacies.
