The following information will be collected since food and drink are served at this establishment:



The name and contact information of at least one person in each party



At least one person in the party must provide an email address and telephone number



Date, check in and check out times



Location of seating (e.g. table number or location on the premises)

If, in the opinion of the Medical Officer of Health, COVID-19 contact tracing or other public health purposes are required, this Customer Information shall be disclosed to the Medical Officer of Health or a public health inspector for these purposes. The Customer Information must be securely stored for 30 days and then destroyed by the premises operator, if it is not used for the purposes outline above.
