

COVID-19 ADVICE & COMPLAINTS

How to follow COVID-19 health orders and report complaints in our community

QUARANTINE ACT

All individuals permitted to enter Canada are subject to this Order (e.g. migrant farm workers), with the exception of temporary foreign workers, some international students, some approved permanent residents, immediate family members, transiting passengers, members of the Canadian forces, accredited diplomats, etc. See full list of exemptions for travel into Canada [here](#).

These individuals must enter a mandatory 14-day period of isolation, regardless of whether they have any symptoms of COVID-19.

RE-OPENING ONTARIO ACT

Applies to:

- Symptomatic people not isolating
- Re-opening of businesses and new requirements for opening
- Events and gatherings are required to follow the information provided in the emergency orders. Please see updates to the orders [here](#)
- General complaints regarding essential businesses (not physical distancing)
- Individuals that are not complying with the Face Covering [Letter of Instruction*](#) or Face Covering Bylaws enforced by local police
- [O. Reg 364/20](#) Sec 2 directs provincial requirements for face covering
