Tubersol® Order Form

Eligibility Requirements for ordering publicly-funded Tubersol®

According to the Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC), Tubersol® is publicly funded (OHIP-insured) in instances where:

- Clients are identified as contacts of an active TB case;
- Tests deemed to be “medically necessary” by the client’s health care provider;
- Clients under the age of 65 who are entering long-term care facilities. Note: Screening via TST is not recommended for clients over the age of 65;
- Required by an educational institution for admission or continuation in a child care or pre-school program, or a program of study in a school, community college, university or other educational institution.
