Watch for flaccid paralysis in children and teens

- There is emerging evidence in Ontario of paediatric Enterovirus-D68 cases
- EV-D68 is a respiratory virus that may cause acute flaccid paralysis
- Notify the health unit should a patient with EV-D68 present with AFP or unusual or severe clinical manifestations requiring hospitalization
- When ordering EV-D68 testing complete a [Clinical Summary Form](#) along with the [General Test Requisition Form](#)

Shingles Vaccine - Act soon for those aged 71

- Those aged 65 to 70 years (i.e., from the 65th birthday to the day prior to the 71st birthday) are now eligible for free herpes zoster (HZ) vaccine
- On a one-time basis, until December 31, 2016, individuals born in 1945 (i.e., those who are already 71 or will be turning 71 in 2016) are also eligible.
